Title: Nuclear Free One Year Japan -- the way forward for the future of our electricity

Speaker: Hisayo Takada (Climate / Energy Campaigner, NGO Greenpeace Japan)

On the 15th of September 2014, for the first time in nearly half a century Japan is free of nuclear electricity for an entire year. This rapid reduction in nuclear electricity generation is unique in the world history of nuclear power. And significantly, it has caused no electricity blackouts. How Japan is managing its electricity? Is renewable energy really growing? How about 'draining national wealth' by fossil fuel import? What about CO2 emissions? This session aims to share the knowledge to answer these questions and discuss together the way forward for the future of our electricity in Japan.
